The Barossa Regional Gallery, supported by the Barossa Council and funding from the Barossa community, is pleased to launch the inaugural Barossa Women's Artist Residency program, specifically inviting mid-career and established female artists to apply. Subject to funding, the Residency may be across all artforms, be open to artists of any discipline from Australia and overseas and be a minimum of 4 weeks and maximum of 6 weeks in length at a maximum, depending on project funding.

One artist will be selected to take part in the Residency program.

The 2025 Residency will take place between 1 October 2025 and 5th November 2025, with some opportunity for negotiation of start and finish dates between the residency recipient and the Barossa Regional Gallery. Expressions of interest have been extended to close midnight **Monday 30th June, 2025.**
